

# Announcing Public Liability Changes to NSW Strata Insurance

In NSW the new Strata Schemes Management Act 2015 will come into effect on November 30, 2016.

When the Regulations under the Act take effect, one important change in regards to strata insurance will be that the minimum sum insured for Public Liability will be set at \$20Million.
